CCISD Dress Code 2018-2019**

All clothes must be appropriately sized for the student and in good repair. Excessively baggy, tight, torn (holes, rips, tears, patches, etc.) clothing will not be permitted.

TOPS	BOTTOMS
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No halters, strapless garments, spaghetti straps, open underarm shirts, tank tops, clothes exposing the midriff or underarm, pajamas. • Shirts may be required to be tucked in unless they are designed to be worn over the waistline and do not exceed four inches below the waistline. • Hooded garments must be worn with the hood down. • Must wear approved shirt under sweatshirt or sweater. • Westbrook, CCISD schools, sports teams, college/university tops are acceptable. • Suggestive/inappropriate slogans or images, illegal products, alcohol and tobacco are prohibited. • Gang related items are not allowed on campus or any school related activity. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No cut-offs, pajamas, boxer shorts, ripped/taped jeans. • Pants or shorts shall be appropriately sized and worn at the natural waistline. • Tights, leggings, spandex, yoga or exercise pants MUST be covered by mid-thigh length shorts, skirts or dresses. • Shorts, skirts and dresses MUST be at least 5 inch inseam length or longer. • Any garment regardless of what it is called, must be worn no shorter than mid-thigh.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Heels must be comfortable for walking. • No shower shoes, heelies (roller shoes), flip-flops, slides or house slippers. • All shoes must have a back. • All shoes must be in good repair.
COATS/JACKETS	JEWELRY – HAIR – HATS - TATTOOS
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be placed in the student’s locker during school hours. (must be stored upon arrival to study hall/mini-course and remain until dismissal). • Trench coats are not allowed on campus 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Spiked, vulgar images or inappropriate slogans are prohibited • Hair color or styles, which is judged disruptive to the educational process are not permitted • Hats, caps, sweatbands, or any type of head covering garments (except for religious coverings) are not allowed on campus during school hours. • Sunglasses may not be worn in the building • No body piercings other than ears allowed • No visible tattoos allowed
ID Badges	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • During normal school hours, secondary students shall be required to wear unaltered identification badges (ID’s) 	

Failure to comply will result in the student being required to change clothes. All class time missed is considered an unexcused absence. The building administrators determine whether a student’s dress is inappropriate. Repeated offenses may result in more serious disciplinary action. Appropriate discipline procedures shall be followed in all classes.
